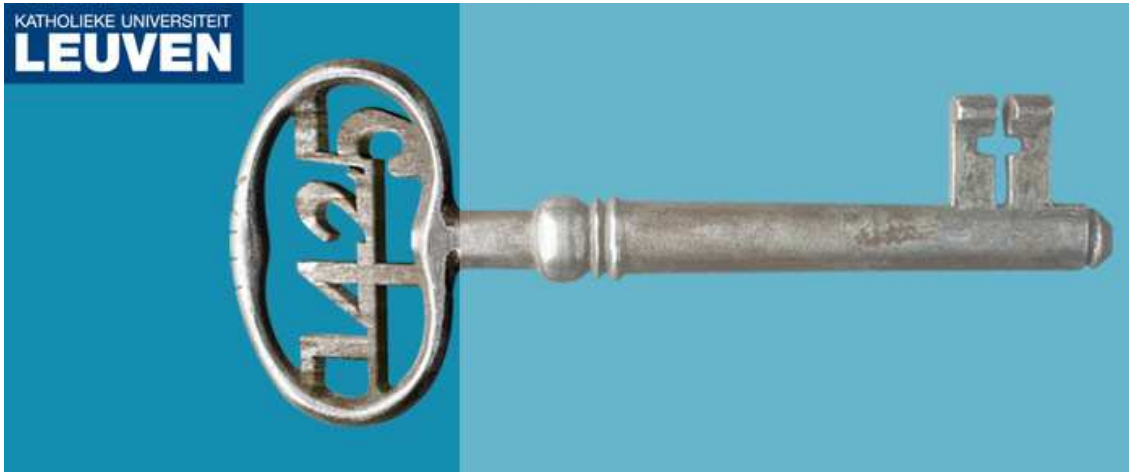


New programme: Postgraduate studies in ICT& MEDIA LAW
