Scope

We are celebrating the 30th anniversary of IFIP TC8 by looking at the past, present and future of information systems looking at the effective design, delivery, use and impact of information technologies in organizations and society. We are inviting leading scholars to give plenary presentations, but we also seek panels and papers to address this theme in relation to the themes of our working groups. Papers describing original work are invited in the areas listed below or other areas of information systems for presentation at the conference.

Topics

Suggested topics for papers include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Design and evaluation of information systems
- Information systems in public administration
- The interaction of information systems and the organization
- Transfer and diffusion of information technology
- Decision support systems
- Smart cards
- E-Business information systems: Multi-disciplinary research and practice

Submission Guidelines

Papers presenting original research in conference topics are being sought. All papers should be submitted electronically on the web site of the conference, <http://www.wcc-2006.org/tc8>, in Portable Document Format (PDF). The name and affiliation of all authors should be included on the paper, and the contact information for the lead author should be added in a cover page. The paper should be sent before **January 15, 2006**.

Papers of no more than 12 pages should be submitted following the norms of the official publisher *Springer Science+Business Media, IFIP Series*. Acceptance will be based on quality, relevance and originality and the practical value of the work. Authors will be notified of acceptance or rejection via e-mail by **March 15, 2006**. Full versions of accepted paper must be written in English, and will be due by **April 7, 2006**.

Panels submission

We also call for panels on this topic. Panel proposals should include panel topic; list of the panelists and chair names, and their main arguments. The submission should follow the same procedure (submission site and dates) as for papers, <http://www.wcc-2006.org/tc8>.
